RECREATIONAL TRAILS

-  Swimming is unsupervised.
Expect: Strong currents, slippery rocks, underwater debris.
-  River is a hydroelectric spillway. A siren indicates water flow in the river is about to become faster and higher.
Get out of the water immediately if you hear a siren.
-  Rocks slippery when wet with a sudden drop off into fast, cold water.
