# **Garbage and Recycling Service Expanded**

In May, residents of Kilmarnock Drive, between Royston and Union Bay, were successful in their petition to the CVRD for an expansion of roadside garbage and recycling service in their community, with about 60 per cent of homes signing on to the petition. The service will cost those residents under \$150/year and should begin in the fall of 2019.

# **Denman Island Bulk Water Supply**

Residents and businesses previously relying on bulk water from the Graham Lake Improvement District will be impacted by changes to supply options, as an on-island solution for bulk water is no longer available. The CVRD is working to consider alternative options for the area understanding that this is creating a challenge for those who have relied on the service in the past. 


## Your Area: Your CVRD Services
