Notes:

- 1. The above form must be signed by a *registered professional*. The British Columbia building code defines a *registered professional* to mean
 - a) a person who is registered or licensed to practise as an architect under the Architects Act, or
 - b) a person who is registered or licensed to practise as a professional engineer under the Engineers and Geoscientists Act
- 2. This form must be submitted along with the application for permit in circumstances where letters of assurance have been required in accordance with sections 10 (1)(a), 10(3), 10(5)(6), 11(2)(1), 11(2)(m) and 11(5)(b) of the Comox Valley Regional District Building Bylaw No. 681, 2024.
- 3. In this form the words in italics have the same meaning as in the British Columbia building code.
