COMOX VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT BYLAW NO. 118

A bylaw to establish the Royston garbage collection service

WHEREAS under section 800 (1) of the *Local Government Act* a regional district may establish and operate a local service;

AND WHEREAS order in council no. 626 was issued by the Lieutenant Governor in Council ordering the transfer of obligations from the Royston Improvement District to the Comox Valley Regional District;

AND WHEREAS the Royston garbage collection service was established as a Comox Valley Regional District service by the conversion of the Royston Improvement District to Comox Valley Regional District services on January 1, 2010;

AND WHEREAS participating area approval has been obtained in writing from the director of Electoral Area 'A' (Baynes Sound – Denman / Hornby Islands) under section 801.5 of the *Local Government Act*:

AND WHEREAS it was deemed necessary to establish a local service area in order to regulate the collection of residential refuse and other types of solid waste as provided by this bylaw within the specified local service area as specified in this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

Description of Service

1. The service established under this bylaw is the service of undertaking, operating and carrying out the collection, removal and disposal of waste and noxious, offensive or unwholesome substances in the service area, including the carrying out of any other act or operation for the reduction, recycling or disposal of waste and noxious, offensive or unwholesome substances.

Service Boundaries

2. The boundaries of the local service area for the Royston garbage collection service are outlined in schedule 'A', attached hereto and forms part of this bylaw.

Participating Area

3. The participating area of the Royston garbage collection service is part of the area within Electoral Area 'A' of the Comox Valley Regional District as shown on the map attached as schedule 'A'.

Cost Recovery Method

4. The cost for the Royston garbage collection service shall be recovered by the imposition of fees and charges.

Maximum Requisition

5. In accordance with section 800.1 (1) (e) of the Local Government Act, the maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the cost of the service is established by this bylaw is the \$0.00 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Citation

6. This Bylaw No. 118 may be cited for all purposes as "Royston Garbage Collection Service Establishment Bylaw No. 118, 2010".
