Smart Burning Tips

You can help reduce the impact of wood smoke in the Comox Valley by burning properly this fall.

Burn Wise - Smart Burning Tips:

- Season your firewood for at least 6 months.
- Avoid burning on days when air pollution is high. Check for any Provincial bans and review the ventilation index before burning.

- Maintain stable, hot combustion conditions. Smouldering leads to higher levels of Particulate Matter (PM) emissions.
- Burn dry by ensuring wood moisture content is less than 20%. **Free moisture meters are available at the CVRD main office.**
