

UPCOMING CHANGES

The Royston Curbside Garbage and Recycling program is changing. Beginning summer 2024 the service may include yard and food waste collection.

Garbage will be collected bi-weekly, with recycling and organic pick up weekly. Residents are encouraged to weigh in on waste by providing their comments and feedback to: cswm@comoxvalleyrd.ca

The Royston collection schedule has moved to Add-A-Day.

This schedule is in line with the municipal collection schedules throughout the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) and has been put in place to mitigate missed collections due to landfill statutory holiday closures. Add-a-day means that curbside collection days will shift by one weekday after every statutory holiday throughout the year. Kindly review your collection schedule and be sure to note the changes in days of the week your waste is collected. Emterra Environmental is RecycleBC's curbside collection partner in Royston. Royston's garbage collection is for one can of garbage per week, as well as unlimited recycling bi-weekly. Tags for additional garbage containers can be purchased at the CVRD office at 770 Harmston Avenue, Courtenay.

Emterra will not pick-up loose garbage. All garbage must be in cans, bagged, closed or tied. A recycling container containing items that are not eligible for curbside service will be tagged and left behind.

ENSURE MORE MATERIALS ARE RECYCLED AND KEPT OUT OF LANDFILL BY **REMEMBERING THESE PRO-TIPS:**

- Line it up. Keep 1m (3ft) between your recycling container and your garbage bin.
- 2 Keep it clean. Empty and rinse all
- 3 Flatten and cut. If your cardboard is too large for your collection container, flatten and cut down to smaller pieces. Stack beside recycling collection container. Remember to keep plastic wrap out of your recycling!
- 4 Make a depot trip. Return glass, foam packaging, plastic bags and overwrap, and other flexible plastic packaging to a RecycleBC depot.







Food, yard waste and wood * Non-paper gift wrap, foil wrap, cards or paper with glitter

- * Rubber bands, ribbons, bows * Padded envelopes
- * Bags and boxes with foil liners
- ★ Paper towels, napkins and tissues
- ★ Foil or plastic lined paper bags

NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS

Exclude batteries; medical sharps; bleach or aerosol containers with any contents remaining; compressed gas cylinders, for example used propane cylinders; containers for paint, motor oil, vehicle lubricants, or antifreeze; or containers for pesticides with the words DANGER, WARNING, or POISON, and precautionary octagon or diamond symbols with skull

and cross bones.
