

Enjoying Electoral Area Parks With Your Pet

Trails in the rural areas offer various opportunities for exercising pets. However, dogs must be under control at all times in CVRD Electoral Area parks and in some parks leashing is mandatory.

Where leashing is not mandatory, ensuring your dog is under control, within sight, and on the trail helps ensure a pleasant park experience for all visitors, gives wildlife the space needed, and protects sensitive environments. In CVRD parks keeping dogs under control means:

- Dogs remain on the trail and within 10 meters (30 feet) of owner
- Dogs must be responsive and immediately return when called
- Dogs must not be harassing or attacking people, wildlife or other pets
- Dogs must be licenced
