

Know the Route; Plan Your Commute

Construction for the Sewer Conveyance Project will begin late March and span over a 30-month period, with the first phase focusing on the Town of Comox and along Lazo Road to the sewer treatment plant.

Construction will be divided into four zones, each with distinct traffic impacts and construction schedules. The second phase will commence in 2025 and involves the construction along Comox Road and Comox Avenue.

To keep the community informed, the CVRD will provide advance notification within two to four weeks before work begins within each zone of construction.
