

Thinking of Building? New Building Bylaw In Effect

The Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) Board adopted the new CVRD Building Bylaw 681. The building bylaw ensures that buildings are constructed to BC Building Code and are safe to occupy.

The new bylaw has been updated to reflect the requirements of the new BC Building Code, BC Building Act, construction industry standards, and includes increases to building permit fees and fines for properties being developed within the electoral areas.

Highlights include:

- Building permits for swimming pools removed.
- Incorporation of BC Energy Step Code requirements.
- Incorporation of BC Building Code requirements.
- Emission requirements for solid fuel fired appliances.
- Increases to building permit fees and fines.
- Expiration condition added to Building Permits
