Stage 1 Water Restrictions Now In Effect

Starting May 1st the below water systems will automatically adjust to be on Stage 1 water restrictions.

- Black-Creek Oyster Bay Local Water System
- Comox Valley Water System
- Royston Local Water System
- Union Bay Local Water System

The Comox Valley Water System includes the Town of Comox, City of Courtenay, and the Comox Valley Water Local Service Area. Under Stage 1, lawn and garden sprinkling is permitted between the hours of 5 am – 8 am and 7 pm – 10 pm, on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday for even numbered addresses and Wednesday, Friday and Sunday for odd numbered addresses.
