

Help Conserve Water This Summer

As we continue to see reduced rain and higher average temperatures in the summer, fresh water becomes an even more limited and precious resource. Water conservation is extremely important to ensure supply for domestic use and emergency fire protection.

In 2023, the Comox Valley Water System recorded a record-high use of over 10 billion litres of water. Water consumption almost triples during the summer months because of outdoor water use, like lawn and garden

watering, when daily water use can exceed well over 1,000 litres per person per day in the Comox Valley.

There are simple ways to help reduce your home and garden water consumption, including installation of low flow fixtures and drought-resistant landscaping, and taking advantage of available rebates.
