# **Parkland Development Cost Charges Timing Change**

The CVRD will be revising the timing of when parkland development cost charges are collected. Development cost charges support the acquisition and development of Electoral Area parks and trails.

Beginning December 5, 2024, all Parkland Development Cost Charges will be collected for each new dwelling at the time of building permit issuance.

Type of Developement	Rate	Unit	When Payable
Single Residential	\$1,417.63	Per Dwelling	Building Permit
Multi-Residential	\$1,181.36	Per Dwelling	Building Permit
Tourist Accomodation	\$212.64	Per Bedroom	Building Permit
