

Weigh in on Waste: Strategies and Actions Now Available

The Comox Strathcona Waste Management (CSWM) service is asking for public feedback on strategies and actions which will help us better manage garbage, recycling, food and other waste over the next decade.

Over the past year, community members, staff and experts have developed eight strategies and 33 actions as part of the renewal of the Solid Waste Management Plan. The update is required by the province every 10 years to reflect the changing needs of communities.

Your feedback will help shape the draft plan, which will be shared with the Regional Solid Waste Advisory Committee, the CSWM Board and the public before it's finalized and submitted to the province in 2026.
