

Be Safe This Halloween, Get Your Fireworks Permit First

Halloween is almost here. If you plan on setting off fireworks Follow these safety tips for a safe and fun time: within the electoral areas of the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD), a fireworks permit is required prior to purchasing. You can buy your permit online or at the CVRD office at 770 Harmston Avenue, Courtenay. Fireworks can only be sold from October 24 until November 1.

If you live in the Comox, Courtenay or Cumberland, contact your municipality for fireworks regulations and permit requirements.

- Purchase your fireworks from a reliable source
- Always place fireworks securely on the ground
- Let your neighbours know you're setting off fireworks

Permits are \$10. Fine for not having a permit is \$500.
