Regional Climate Action Strategy Approved by Board

The Comox Valley Regional District's (CVRD) Board of Directors approved the Regional Climate Action Strategy on January 27 and directed staff to begin implementing recommended actions. The strategy identifies actions that focus on mitigation, adaptation, and resilience to reduce our community greenhouse gas emissions and adapt our community to a changing climate. It also identifies actions that require regional coordination and support from senior levels of government.

It includes 70 actions that target clean energy, sustainable transportation, education, collaboration, policy, infrastructure upgrades, hazard mitigation, and flood protection. Together, these actions help make homes more comfortable, improve access to clean and reliable transportation, support people who may feel climate impacts first, and strengthen essential services.
