The CVRD, K'ómoks First Nation and partners welcome you to the newly reopened qapoje Park (formally Dyke Road Park). qapoje (kah-poh'-jeh) means "spring salmon in a creek flowing south". It is the traditional ayajusem term for Coho Creek, which flows from Back Road, under Comox Road, through

the park and into the estuary. Come out and enjoy this beautiful reopened space.
