Planning Fees & Procedures Bylaw Update

New application fees under the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) Planning Fees, Procedures and Delegation Bylaw No. 899, 2026, will take effect on September 7. The new fee schedule was introduced in May 2026, with implementation of updated application fees delayed to provide applicants, builders, and property owners additional time through the summer under the current fee schedule.

What's Changing

- Streamlined review process for some applications
- Updated public notice requirements
- Inflation-adjusted application fees

Applications received on or before September 7 will be processed on the old fee schedule.
