The Great BC ShakeOut

October 16, 2014

WHEREAS major earthquakes pose a particular, significant, and ongoing threat to the entire Comox Valley; and

WHEREAS the Comox Valley Regional District (CVRD) has a responsibility to promote earthquake preparedness internally as well as with the public and plan appropriately for earthquake-related disasters; and

WHEREAS community preparedness to earthquakes and other disasters relies on the preparedness levels of all stakeholders in the community – individuals, families, schools, community organizations, businesses, and government; and
