


Census Population of the Comox Valley

In 2016, the census population of Comox Valley was 66,527, an increase of 4.7 per cent from 2011. Of this number, 34.8 per cent (23,147) live in K'ómoks First Nation and electoral areas, and the remaining 65.2 per cent (43,380) live in municipalities.




Population Changes in CVRD Electoral Areas
