AFFIDAVIT

- I, RUSSELL DYSON, municipal civil servant, of 600 Comox Road, Courtenay, British Columbia, V9N 3P6, SWEAR THAT:
- I have personal knowledge of the matters hereinafter deposed to, save and except where those matters are stated to be based on information and belief, and to such latter matters, I verily believe the same to be true.
- I swear this my Affidavit in support of the Response of the Respondent Comox Valley Regional District (the "Regional District") to the Amended Petition in this matter. Except where stated otherwise, I adopt in this my Affidavit the defined terms used in my 1st Affidavit sworn on December 19, 2018, in this matter.
- In my 1st Affidavit sworn on December 19, 2018, in this matter, I stated that I first became aware of the Allegation (i.e., that 3L Developments alleged that Ms. Ann MacDonald, the then General Manager of Planning and Development Services of the Regional District, had stated to 3L Developments in June/July

2016 that "it would be a frosty Friday in hell" before the Regional District would approve the proposed Riverwood Development) in December 2017, and that, at no time prior to December 2017, did 3L Developments advise the Regional District of the Alleged MacDonald Statement.

- I have reviewed the 2nd Affidavit of Kabel Atwall sworn on January 25, 2019, in this matter, and have reviewed the letter dated November 16, 2017 addressed to me from 3L Developments. The letter does not attribute the "Frosty Friday in hell, before our application is approved" comments to Ms. MacDonald. Had the letter specifically attributed the comments to Ms. MacDonald, I would have addressed the reference with Ms. MacDonald in the same manner as I addressed the Allegation with her, as described in my 1st Affidavit.
- 5. After the Regional Board resolved to adopt the Recommended Consultation Plan, subject to the Board Specified Amendments, (the "Approved Consultation Plan") on August 14, 2018, Regional District staff moved forward with the implementation of the Approved Consultation Plan.
- 6. In accordance with the Approved Consultation Plan, on August 17, 2018, I wrote to the Wei Wai Kum First Nation and the Homalco Indian Band giving notice of initiation of the Amendment and to provide information relating to the Amendment (through a link to the Regional District's website). Attached to this my Affidavit as Exhibits "A" & "B" are true copies of my letters dated August 17, 2018, to the Wei Wai Kum First Nation and the Homalco Indian Band respectively. Attached to this my Affidavit as Exhibit "C" is a true copy of the courier receipts indicating that my letters dated August 17, 2018, to the Wei Wai Kum First Nation and the Homalco Indian Band were delivered to them on August 17, 2018.

- 7. I sent separate letters to the Chiefs and Band Managers of each of the Wei Wai Kum First Nation and the Homalco Indian Band. While my letters were addressed correctly to the current Band Managers for each of the them, I note that my letters were unfortunately addressed incorrectly to the former Chiefs of each of them.
- 8. In accordance with the Approved Consultation Plan, on August 17, 2018, I wrote the K'omoks First Nation giving notice of initiation of the Amendment and to provide information relating to the Amendment (through a link to the Regional District's website). Attached to this my Affidavit as Exhibit "D" is a true copy of my letter dated August 17, 2018, to the K'omoks First Nation and the K'omoks First Nation's email response to that latter.
- 9. In accordance with the Approved Consultation Plan, on August 17, 2018, I wrote to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing giving notice of initiation of the Amendment and to provide information relating to the Amendment (through a link to the Regional District's website). Attached to this my Affidavit as Exhibit "E" is a true copy of my letter dated August 17, 2018, to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing.
- 10. At the October 2, 2018, meeting of the Regional Board wherein the Regional Board ultimately approved the Denial Motion, prior to the Board voting on the Denial Motion, former Board Director Larry Jangula commented that it may be inappropriate for the Regional Board to consider the Amendment at that time as there was going to be a local government election later that month. The Regional Board Chair, Bruce Joliffe, did not take Director Jangula to be making a formal motion to defer consideration of the Amendment. It appeared that Director Jangula was simply making a comment in the context of the discussion of the Amendment. In any event, Director Jangula's comments/purported motion were not seconded by any other Board Director, and were not debated by the Board.

- 11. At the October 2, 2018, meeting of the Regional Board, 3L Developments submitted a letter requesting to withdraw the RGS Amendment Application, (the "Withdrawal Request") while the Board was actively considering the Denial Motion. The Denial Motion had already been moved and seconded, and was on the table for discussion by the Regional Board. To my knowledge, the Regional Board had never before received a request to withdraw a development application while the application was on the table and was being actively considered by the Board at a Board meeting.
- 12. Board Chair Joliffe recessed the Regional Board meeting in order to confer with Regional District staff in relation to the procedural issues relating to the Withdrawal Request and a motion being on the table for consideration by the Regional Board.
- During the recess in the Regional Board meeting, Board Chair Joliffe and the Board Vice Chair, Bob Wells, who are responsible under the Comox Valley Regional District Procedure Bylaw No. 1, 2008, for addressing procedural matters at Board meetings, discussed the procedural issues relating to the Withdrawal Request with James Warren, the Regional District's General Manager of Corporate Services, Jake Martens, the Regional District's Manager of Legislative Services, Alana Mullaly, the Regional District's Senior Manager of Planning and Protective Services, and me.
- 14. The discussion between Board Chair Joliffe, Board Vice Chair Wells, James Warren, Jake Martens, Alana Mullaly, and me was solely related to the procedural issues relating to the Withdrawal Request
- 15. After conferring with Regional District staff, Board Chair Joliffe and Board Vice Chair Wells determined that withdrawal of the RGS Amendment Application was at the discretion of the Regional Board as the Denial Motion was on the table and was being debated.

16. The discussion between Board Chair Joliffe, Board Vice Chair Wells, James Warren, Jake Martens, Alana Mullaly, and me was not part of the October 2, 2018, meeting of the Regional Board. No other Board members were involved in the discussion. There was not a quorum of Board members involved in the discussion.
