ADVANCE ELECTOR REGISTRATION

Are you eligible to vote at the Saratoga / Miracle Beach Sewer Service Establishment Referendum to be held February 4th, 2006? Is your name on the current list of electors?

If you are not sure, you can find out by calling or visiting the Regional District offices, Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays) from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Advance elector registrations will be accepted at the above location until 4:30 p.m. on Friday, January 11th, 2006.

Advance registration will not be available after January 11th, 2006. A person who has not registered as an elector by Wednesday, January 11, 2006, must register immediately before voting on Voting Day or at an advance or special voting opportunity.

ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

NOTE: The Saratoga / Miracle Beach Sewer Service Area includes the defined portion of Electoral Area 'C' (Black Creek – Puntledge) in the Regional District of Comox-Strathcona.

Resident Electors

- Age 18 or older; and
- A Canadian citizen; and
- A resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- A resident of the proposed Saratoga / Miracle Beach Sewer Service Area for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- Not disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-Resident Property Electors

- Age 18 or older; and
- A Canadian citizen; and
- A resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration; and
- A registered owner of real property in the proposed Saratoga / Miracle Beach Sewer Service Area for at least 30 days immediately before the day of registration; and
- Not entitled to register as a resident elector; and
- The only persons who are registered owners of the property must be individuals who do not hold title to the property in trust for a corporation or another trust; and
- Not disqualified by any enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law; and
- If there is more than one registered owner of the property, only one of those individuals may, with the written consent of the majority of the owners, register as a non-resident property elector.

If you qualify as a non-resident property elector, it is suggested that you contact the Regional District office for further information on registering.

Proof of Identity

To register as a Resident Elector or a Non-Resident Elector, two pieces of identification must be provided. The documents must indicate the residential address of the applicant and a signature.
