

COMOX VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 427

A bylaw to establish a south sewer collection service to finance and construct all collection systems serving initial Electoral Area A participants and any trunk sewer infrastructure that would be of sole benefit to those participants

WHEREAS under section 332 of the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1) a regional district may operate any service the board considers necessary or desirable for all or part of the regional district;

AND WHEREAS the board of the Comox Valley Regional District wishes to establish a service to finance and construct all collection systems and any trunk sewer infrastructure serving initial Electoral Area A participants;

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Inspector of Municipalities has been obtained under section 342 of the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1);

AND WHEREAS the approval for the participating area was obtained by assent of the electors under section 344 of the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1);

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

Service

1. (1) The service established by this bylaw is to construct any collection or trunk sewer infrastructure that would be of sole benefit to lands in the service area within that part of Electoral Area A within the boundaries described in section 2 of this bylaw.
- (2) The service shall be known as the South Sewer Service (Area A Capital) (the ‘service’).

Boundaries

2. The boundaries of the service area are coterminous with the boundaries of those portions of Electoral Area ‘A’ (Baynes Sound – Denman/Hornby Islands) as identified in schedule ‘A’ attached to and forming part of this bylaw.

Participating area

3. Electoral Area ‘A’ (Baynes Sound – Denman/Hornby Islands) is the sole participating area in the service.

Cost recovery

4. As provided in section 378 of the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1), the annual cost for this service shall be recovered by one or more of the following:
 - (a) parcel taxes;
 - (b) fees and charges imposed under section 397 of the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1);
 - (c) revenues raised by other means authorized by the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1) or another Act; and
 - (d) revenues received by way of agreement, enterprise, gift, grant or otherwise,

Maximum requisition

5. In accordance with section 339(1)(e) of the *Local Government Act* (SBC, 2015, c. 1), the maximum amount that may be requisitioned annually for the cost of the service is \$686,000.

Service review

6. All aspects of the South Sewer Service (Area A Capital) shall be reviewed every five years, with the first review occurring in 2021.

Citation

This Bylaw No. 427 may be cited as “South Sewer Service (Area A Capital) Establishment Bylaw No. 427, 2016”.
