


ADVISORY: Ryan Road Construction Set to Begin

In early June, the Comox Valley Regional District started work on the Greenwood Trunk sewer line. This will increase capacity in the Comox Valley sewer system by connecting areas of East Courtenay directly to the sewage treatment plant.

Work has already been completed around the 19 Wing Fitness/Community Centre, Oceanspray Road, and Belair Road. Construction will now move onto Ryan Road around July 16 and will progress from Belair to just west of Hudson Road, before turning north onto right-of-ways.

What you need to know:

- Single-lane alternating traffic will be required to complete this work. Drivers should expect delays during this time.
- The pipe will be installed on the southside of Ryan Road. Access to businesses on the northside (even-numbered addresses) will see no change to access.
- For properties on the southside (odd-numbered addresses), there will be periods where driveway access is disrupted. The contractor will be in touch directly to confirm times and make plans with individual property owners/users.
- The work is expected to last up to 20 business days: to be completed around Aug. 10.



Work on the new Greenwood Trunk sewer line is expected to be complete by early December 2018.
