ADVISORY: Revised Construction Schedule

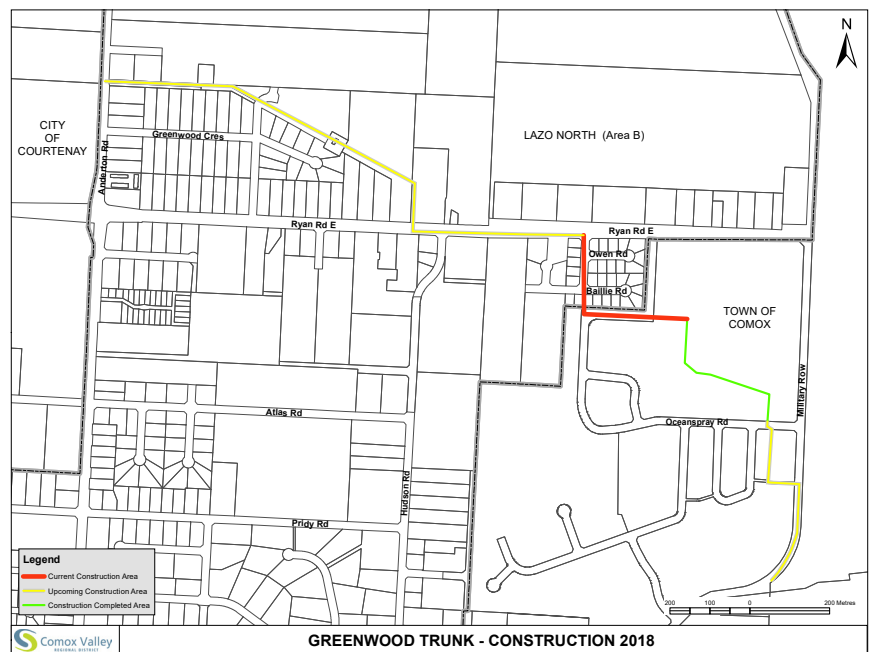
In early June, the Comox Valley Regional District started work on the Greenwood Trunk sewer line. This will increase capacity in the Comox Valley sewer system by connecting areas of East Courtenay directly to the sewage treatment plant.

Earlier this month, a news bulletin was sent out with information around upcoming work and timing – and there has since been some changes to the schedule. Currently, work is proceeding well, which means that residents in the area can expect to see construction sooner than originally anticipated.

What you need to know:

- Properties on Baillie Road that back onto Oceanspray Road will see excavation behind their property starting this Thursday June 28th.
- Construction on Belair Road is expected to begin around the week of July 2nd and last for about one week. All people who use this road to access homes will come across construction activity and will likely encounter delays.

Work on the new Greenwood Trunk sewer line is expected to be complete by early December 2018.
