

New forcemain project ready to get rolling

Construction on a new stretch of gravity main, which will tie areas of East Courtenay directly to the Comox Valley Regional District's sewage treatment plant, is set to begin in early June.

The new line will begin on Military Row near the Comox Valley Airport and end at the eastern boundary of the City of Courtenay (Anderton Road, between Hamilton and Greenwood Crescent) (see map on Pg. 2).

The Greenwood Trunk sanitary sewer collection line will increase capacity in the Comox Valley sewer system by relieving pressure on the Courtenay Pump Station.

What this means for you:

- Throughout April, in preparation for construction, you may have already noticed some tree removal work along a CVRD utility right-of-way on Department of National Defence land.
- The next stage of work will see construction start along the access at the 19 Wing Fitness and Community Centre, before moving to Ryan Road and onto Anderton (see schedule on Pg. 2).
- Once connected at Anderton Road, crews will loop back and complete work on Military Row.
- Traffic disruptions and intermittent alternating one-way traffic can be expected along the route
- Construction is expected to last around six months to be complete by early December 2018.

Stay tuned for updates on work as it progresses and watch for more of these news bulletins over the coming months.



Construction Schedule

Dates	Area
June-July	Start at 19 Wing Fitness/Community Centre Access (Snowberry Ave)
July-Aug	Oceanspray Rd, Belair Rd and Ryan Rd
Sept-Oct	Ryan Rd to Anderton Rd via right-of-ways
Oct-Nov	Military Row, Rose Ave, Hardhack Street
Nov-Dec	Final paving, landscaping and demobilization

Quick Facts

Here's what you need to know:

WHAT: A new sanitary sewer line connecting east Courtenay to the CVRD's sewage treatment plant is being built.

WHO: The CVRD is constructing the Greenwood Trunk forcemain. Engineering services are provided by ISL Engineering and Wacor is the project contractor.

WHERE: Construction will start at the 19 Wing Fitness and Community Centre access road and proceed to Anderton Road between Hamilton and Greenwood Crescent. Work will then loop back to Military Row to complete the route.

WHEN: Construction will begin in early June and is expected to be complete by early December.

WHY: The work will provide additional servicing to an area of growth, as well as alleviate capacity issues within the current system, by directing flows away from the Courtenay Pump Station.
