COMOX VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW NO. 108

A bylaw to delegate the authority to enforce the Comox Valley Regional District bylaws

WHEREAS under sections 176(1)(e) of the *Local Government Act* the board may, by bylaw, delegate its authority to enforce regional district bylaws to its compliance officers and other employees certain powers, duties and functions;

AND WHEREAS the board of the Comox Valley Regional District wishes to delegate to its officers and employees the certain powers, duties and functions to enforce its bylaws

NOW THEREFORE the board of the Comox Valley Regional District in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

Citation

1. This Bylaw No. 108 may be cited for all purposes as “Comox Valley Regional District Bylaw Compliance Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 108, 2010.”

Definitions

2. In this bylaw:
 - a) Board means the board of the Comox Valley Regional District.
 - b) Bylaw Compliance Officer means the General Manager of Planning and Development Services, and/or the Senior Manager of Planning and Protective Services, and/or the General Manager of Engineering Services and/or the Manager of Bylaw Compliance or their delegates, including peace officers.
 - c) Chief Administrative Officer Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) means the officer of the regional district assigned Chief Administrative Officer responsibility under section 235 of the *Local Government Act*.
 - d) Regional District means the Comox Valley Regional District.

Jurisdiction

3. This bylaw is applicable to and enforceable within Electoral Areas ‘A’, ‘B’ and ‘C’.

Regional District Board Authority

4.
 - (1) The fundamental responsibility for the enforcement of the regional district bylaws rests with the regional district board. The regional district board is responsible to enact bylaws on matters that the board wishes to regulate or is required to regulate by law.
 - (2) The board shall consider all enforcement matters that may require Supreme Court or direct action enforcement on the part of the board.

Administration of Bylaws

5. The responsibilities of administering the enforcement activities of a regional district bylaw are delegated as follows:
- a) the General Manager of Planning and Development Services shall oversee the Manager of Building Services or Building Inspectors who shall administer the enforcement of the regional district building bylaws;
 - b) the General Manager of Engineering Services shall oversee the Manager of Water Services who shall administer the enforcement of the Comox Valley Water Conservation Bylaw;
 - c) the General Manager of Planning and Development Services and Senior Manager of Planning and Protective Services shall oversee the Manager of Bylaw Compliance or the Bylaw Compliance Officers who shall be responsible to administer the enforcement of regional district zoning bylaws and other regulatory bylaws;
 - d) the General Manager of Planning and Development Services and Senior Manager of Planning and Protective Services shall oversee the Manager of Bylaw Compliance or the Bylaw Compliance Officers or agents who shall be responsible for the enforcement of the regional district animal control bylaw and parks regulations bylaw;
 - e) the General Manager of Community Services shall oversee the Manager of Fire Services who shall oversee the Fire Chief, or Deputy Fire Chief, or their delegates as appointed from time to time in writing who shall administer the enforcement of the regional district fire control and regulation bylaws;
 - f) the Chief Administrative Officer shall oversee direct enforcement action relating to voluntary compliance and quasi-criminal proceedings in provincial court.”
